The **Forest Stewardship Plan for the Eagles Mere Conservancy** completed a forest stewardship plan for the Conservancy's 379 acres of forested land. The plan includes maps, background information, descriptions of the forest, list of species observed, and recommendations for future stewardship projects. The management of this community forest has greatly benefited the local population and the restoration needs of the forest.

- Species inventory completed by volunteers;
- Created a forest stewardship plan to be used on future stewardship plans for 2002-2012; and
- Maps created with FARMS (Forest and Resource Management System) software.
