Milford Square Enhancement Project, Phase II

The **Milford Square Enhancement Project, Phase II** continued work in Milford Borough which was previously funded by this Program. Work focused on restoring the tree line within the historic Milford community and reclaiming the downtown as a pedestrian-friendly environment. **Phase II** included the Broad and Hartford Streets intersection and extends along Broad Street to Anne Street.

Significant Revisions to Scope of Work

The original work plan was scaled down after bids were received.

Project Accomplishments

- Planted 38 deciduous trees including 35 canopy and 3 flowering;
- Planted 70 shrubs and 954 herbaceous plants;
- The Delta Group, landscape architects, created a plan for the project site; and
- Presentation to potential large contributors at the Muir House.
